DANVILLE BUDGET COMMITTEE

Minutes of our December 1st, 2015 meeting

Chairman Tom Billbrough, Sr. called this organizational meeting of the FY2015 Danville Budget Committee to order at 7:30 PM, with 5 of 6 members present.

The first order of business was the review of the minutes from our November 17th meeting. Shawn made a motion to accept the minutes as written. Kathy seconded the motion and the motion carried unanimously. Our 6th member (Jeff) arrived immediately after the vote.

Next we reviewed the proposed FY2016 Highway budgets; Bruce and Beth were both present to answer questions. The first budge we reviewed was 4312.20 Road Maintenance. At the conclusion of our discussion Tom made a motion to accept a modified budget in the amount of \$410,000. (\$305 was removed from the proposed hw-661 Vehicle Fuel line.) John seconded the motion, which passed unanimously.

We then reviewed the proposed 4312.30 Storm-Water Management budget. At the conclusion of our review Jeff made a motion to fund the line in the requested amount of \$12,500. George seconded the motion, which passed unanimously.

Lastly we reviewed the 4312.50 Winter account. At the conclusion of our review, John made a motion to fund the line in the requested amount of \$167,000. George seconded the motion, which passed unanimously.

We then moved on to the 4210 Police budgets. Wade was present to answer question, while Sheila was present to answer question relative to the ACO budget. After a relative quick review of the 4210.10 Police Department budget, George made a motion to fund the account in the requested amount of \$462,878. John seconded the motion which passed unanimously.

Lastly we did a lengthy review of the 4210.2 Animal Control budget, contrasting what the BoS presented with that requested by the elected ACO. At the end of our discussions, Jeff made a motion to fund the Animal Control budget in the amount of \$6,655 as follows:
