Our first action was to review the minutes of our December 22nd meeting. George made a motion to accept the minutes as written. John seconded the motion and the motion carried unanimously.

Tom then asked for the review of a number of budgets that we had not previously reviewed and for which we had not proposed a recommended budget amount. In all cases, the committee voted unanimously to recommend the proposed amounts. The budgets reviewed, as well as the person who recommended the proposed budget, the recommended budget amount and the person who seconded the motion are as follows:

Next we reviewed the BoS proposed FY2016 Revenue Budget in the amount of \$1,141,600. The motion was seconded by Jeff and passed unanimously.
