## Caregivers Expand Services

DANVILLE — Community Caregivers of Greater Derry has announced the expansion of caregiving services in the town of Danville. Danville will add to the six towns that currently are served by Community Caregivers volunteers: Derry, Londonderry, Windham, Sandown, Chester and Hampstead.

Caregivers, through a volunteer network, assist the elderly and disabled with services such as friendly visiting, respite care, grocery shopping, light chores, light home repair

and maintenance, yard work and medical transportation. In 2010, Community Caregivers volunteers spent over 25,000 hours, helping individuals over 10,000 times and drove over 97,000 miles to and from doctor's offices and assisting with grocery shopping and errands. Services offered through Caregivers are vitally important as they allow individuals to maintain independence in the community and home environment. All services are free of charge.

Prospective volunteers of all ages are encouraged to attend an information session at the Danville Town Hall, on Fri., July 15, at 12 noon, or Mon., July 18, at 7:00 p.m. Opportunities are available from just once a month to once a week. Community Support is crucial in starting this expansion project.
