### FIRE DEPARTMENT

The Danville Fire Department strives to serve you better. One way you can help us is by placing your house number on your mailbox, a post, or anywhere easily visible from the street. Three inch high reflective numbers are great especially for us at night. This will help us get to you faster in a time of emergency. If you have any questions please contact the Danville Fire Department at 382-5133.

The Danville Fire Department issues annual Burn Permits to residents so that they may burn brush in their yards. Once you receive your permit, call the station and let us know that you will be burning that evening. Burning is allowed after 5:00pm unless it is raining or snow-covered. The Fire Towers are open from 9:00am – 5:00pm so outside burning is not allowed during the day. Brush fires must be attended at all times. You may not burn trash, treated wood or material greater than 5" in diameter. *You may pick up your Burn Permit at the Fire Station.*

The Danville Fire Department wishes to thank the Danville Fire Association for the donation of the Jaws-of-Life power unit. This piece of equipment is a valuable tool used during auto accidents and needed to be replaced immediately as the power unit we had was old and recently taken out of service. The Fire Association held a special meeting to vote for the \$8,000 donation. On behalf of the residents the Danville Fire Department wishes to thank the members for their generous donation.

### ANIMAL CONTROL OFFICER

**Dog Licenses Reminder:** Under State law all dogs 4 months old or older must have been licensed by April 30th and wear the license tag at all times. All dogs that have not been registered by June 1<sup>st</sup> are subject to a \$25.00 fine plus fees.

**Vehicle Registrations:** Mail in registrations are now in effect. The new forms implemented by the State on September 9, 2008 will be returned as your official registration form.

Registrations done in person must be submitted by the person whose name is on the registration along with the old registration.

### BULKY WASTE COLLECTION DAYS

### HOUSEHOLD HAZARDOUS WASTE DAY

Household Hazardous Waste day will be May 9<sup>th</sup> in Plaistow, at the athletic field on Old County Road. The next collection will be October 31<sup>st</sup> at the Danville Town Hall. Further information to follow.

Residents – please note **CLEARLY MARK** your address on your trash cart. Carts remain with the property.

If your cart is misplaced or stolen contact the Danville Police Department to report a theft. Replacement cost is \$60.00 and is the responsibility of the homeowner.

Residents – please remember **DO NOT OVER FILL YOUR TRASH CART**. The cover must be closed. Do not leave any other trash next to the cart, as Waste Management will only take what is in the cart. Your cooperation is appreciated.

### SINGLE STREAM RECYCLING

No sorting is necessary. All materials; paper, cardboard, glass, metal and plastic can all go in the same container. You may use standard bin or barrel, up to 36 gallons for recycling. Please continue to rinse out all containers, remove plastic bags and liners and break down boxes and cardboard in order to maximize space and the amount you recycle.

### RESIDENTIAL TRASH BURNING

RSA 125-N state law prohibits residential trash burning – a public health risk.

Today's trash contains inks, dyes, chlorine, plastics, toxic, metals and a variety of synthetic materials that can produce toxins when burned

## MOSQUITO CONTROL

Mosquito Control program began April 13<sup>th</sup>. They are checking for mosquito larvae and if/when found the following insecticides may be used: VectoBac (Bacillus thuringiensis israelensis), Altosid (methoprene), Agnique MMF (poly-isooctadecyl-hydroxyl), Mosquito Larvicide GB-111 (aliphatic petroleum, hydrocarbons) and BVA 2 Mosquito Larvicide Oil (highly refined petroleum distillate).

Residents who do not want their property treated must contact Dragon Mosquito Control in writing at P.O. Box 46, Stratham, NH 03885.
