Minutes:

David and Jim seconded a motion to approve the August 10, 2017 minutes as written. Chip abstained. The motion passed.

Judy Jervis spoke with the Board regarding her property on Far View Drive. When the road was continued and the cul-de-sac reverted to expand her front yard, a deed was never recorded as suggested by the town engineer at that time. It was agreed that this should be done at the town's expense. The Selectmen will be asked about granting the road to the Jervis's.

David Acheson of 4 Arbor Lane presented a lot merger application to the Board. His wife, Kelly Wood, is the legal owner of three abutting parcels known as map and lot 3-124 (20.15 acres), 3-130 (.23 acre), and 3-131-B (.06 acre). Chip made and Roger seconded a **motion to accept the application**. The motion **passed** unanimously.

The board agreed that the lot merger does not violate any zoning ordinance. The merge eliminates two non-conforming lots. Chip made and David seconded a **motion to approve the lot merger**. The motion **passed** unanimously.

The board reviewed the mylar for the Sandown subdivision brought in by Jim Lavelle, in which a portion of the parcel is in Danville. There are still some issues with missing lot numbers and abutter names. The plan will be returned to Mr. Lavelle for more edits.

At 8:00pm Roger made and Chip seconded a **motion to adjourn**. The motion **passed** unanimously.
