## FIRE DEPARTMENT

The warmer months are here finally! We want everyone to be happy and safe. Here are some tips to help us help you!

**\*Number your mailbox and house** so that we can find your home in emergencies.

**\*Clean your chimneys** to help prevent fires.

**\*Check your Smoke and CO Detectors** to make sure they have battery back-up. Did you know some wired detectors do not have any batteries and won't work during power outages? Check and replace any detectors that are more than 7 years old.



**Burn permits** are required in Danville. They can be acquired at the Station during regular hours.

**By burning waste oil we save tax dollars!** Please bring your waste oil to us. Burning waste oil has reduced heating costs and saved your tax dollars.

**Business hours:** Monday - Friday 8am to 4pm and Wednesday evenings from 7pm to 9pm.

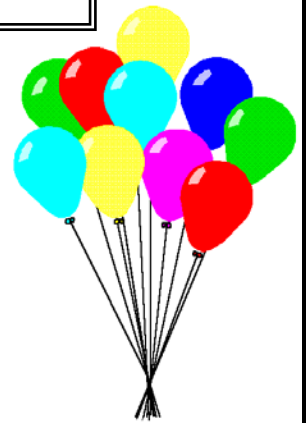
### HIGHWAY DEPARTMENT
