All in favor, motion carries with a vote of 5-0. 27 28 Walter stated he had done some research in regards to amendments to the Rules of Procedure and 29 brought in some documentation which was handed out to the Board. He suggests that the Board 30 members take some time to review the documents and discuss at the next meeting. David noted that the Board needs to be consistent. Walter agrees and added that the Board needs to follow procedure 31 32 so as not to end up in court. Walter suggests having the Road Agent and Code Enforcement Officer 33 come to a meeting at some point to make sure everyone is on the same page. Roger mentions that our 34 ordinance is more rigid than the State. 35 David made and John 2nd a motion to adjourn. All in favor, motion carries with a vote of 5-0.
