

Planning Board
May 28, 2020

Richard was designated a voting member for tonight's meeting.

Chip made and Richard seconded the **motion to accept the May 14, 2020 minutes as written**. Jennifer abstained. The motion **passed**.

Chip said he is still working on the updates to the table of contents in the Zoning Ordinance and the letters for the CIP.

The town received some state funding to help with any covid-19 related issues. It was agreed the Planning Board has not incurred any extra costs due the pandemic.

Post Subdivision:

The Board reviewed the Selectman minutes from May 18, 2020 which were noted to be the draft minutes. The motion was made, seconded, and approved to accept the road bond. After a short discussion, Chip made and Roger seconded a **motion to grant final approval for Bright Star Farm, map and lot 4-94**. The motion **passed** unanimously.

Impact fees were discussed. School and safety impact fees will apply to the new lots created. The existing home does not have an impact fee due. The impact fees for a single-family home are \$4933.00 for the school and \$1706 for safety. It was explained that the land use change tax is different. This is typically paid by the landowner because they have benefited by the current use tax break. Chip made and Roger seconded a **motion to impose the impact fees as discussed for the 11 new lots created for a total of \$73,029**. The motion **passed** unanimously.

There was a short discussion about the road construction process, including the town engineer inspections. Dorothea and Bud Post requested that the \$12,000 bond already given to the town be refunded. They were told to speak with the Board of Selectmen as they hold the bond. The \$3000 for the inspection fees is in place and any unexpended funds will be returned.

The Board was thanked for their cooperation.

The mylars will be signed and the Board requested three paper copies of the complete plans for signatures.

Other Business:

It was the consensus of the Board to meet on the second Thursday only during June, July, and August.

One person was elected in March and has been sworn in but has not attended meetings. Gail was asked to contact this person to see if they intend to participate.
