The Danville Police Department currently shares space with our fire department in the Kimball Safety Complex located on 208 Main St. Built in 1988, this complex was defined as temporary quarters for the police department. Thirty Five years later in a growing town, police operations are still conducted in the same four room area, 750SQ FT.
