

- Check your Smoke and CO Detectors to make sure they have battery back-up. We have found many homes have wired detectors but are old and do not have any battery back-up. Please check and replace any detectors that are more than 7 years old.
- Burn Permits are required in NH for burning brush. Please stop in during business hours and get your Annual Burn Permit and the rules for outside burns.
- We save you tax dollars by burning waste oil! Please bring your waste oil in during business hours. Burning waste oil in the equipment bay furnace has saved a lot in fuel costs.
