

## DANVILLE, NH BULK PICK-UP REQUEST FORM Pick-up date: OCTOBER 20, 2018

## IF YOU WISH TO PARTICIPATE IN BULK PICK-UP,

## YOU MUST RETURN THIS FORM TO THE SELECTMEN'S OFFICE BY OCT. 10.

If you have something that can be broken down and put in your Casella toter, it should <u>not</u> be put out for bulk.

Please review the following guidelines:

- 1. For Danville residents only!
- 2. Items should be placed curbside no more than one week prior to the pick-up date. *Place tarps over upholstered items to keep out the rain/snow. Your taxes pay per ton and rain/snow adds unnecessary weight.*
- 3. A single item or bundle should not weigh more than 50 pounds.
- 4. You are allowed an area no larger than 8'x10'. *Items outside this area will not be picked up.*
- 5. Limit of four rimless tires.

The following items will be picked up curbside for a <u>pre-paid fee</u> payable to the Town of Danville. The fee applies to each item, i.e. two TVs will incur a \$100 fee.

- Washer, dryer \$25 each
- Dish washer \$25
- Hot water heater \$25
- Dehumidifier \$25
- Stove furnace (not brick) \$25
- Microwaves \$25

- Air conditioners \$50
- Refrigerators, freezers \$50 each
- Televisions \$50
- Computer equipment (CPUs, laptops, monitors, printers) - \$50 each

The following items are not allowed and will not be picked up as part of bulk:

- Propane tanks
- Fluorescent light bulbs
- Batteries
- Any mechanical equipment with diesel, gasoline, or oil in it
- Paint cans (not dry)
- Yard waste
- Tires with rim
- Household garbage or recycling
- 'piles' of construction debris

## Danville residents may use the Raymond Transfer Station any time of year.
