DANVILLE, NH BULKY ITEM PICK-UP REQUEST FORM

Pick-up date: April 27, 2024

IF YOU WISH TO PARTICIPATE IN BULKY ITEM PICK-UP,

YOU MUST RETURN THIS FORM TO THE **SELECTMEN'S OFFICE** BY April 19, 2024 NO EXCEPTIONS.

If you have something that can be broken down and put in your Casella toter, that's where it should go.

- 1. If a house number is not obvious from the street (on your mailbox, house front, etc) your items will be left at the curb.*
- 2. Curbside bulky item pick-up is for Danville residents and for residences only!
- 3. Items should be placed curbside no more than one week prior to the pick-up date. Place tarps over upholstered items to keep out the rain/snow. Your taxes pay per ton and rain/snow adds unnecessary weight. Please remove tarps and/or items prior to 7am the day of pick-up if you intend to keep the item.
- 4. You are allowed an area no larger than 8'x10'. Items outside this area will not be picked up.
- 5. Limit of four rimless tires.
- 6. This is for bulky items only. Examples include the following: couch, mattress, table, headboard, etc.

If it fits in a trunk or backseat of a vehicle, take it to the Raymond Transfer Station on Prescott Road which is off Route 107.

The following items will be picked up curbside for a <u>fee</u>, please contact Casella directly at 800-445-1318. The fee applies to each item, i.e. two TVs will incur a \$100 total fee.

- Washer, dryer \$25 each
- Dish washer \$25
- Hot water heater \$25
- Dehumidifier \$25
- Stove furnace (not brick) \$25
- Microwaves \$25

Air conditioners - \$50

- Refrigerators, freezers \$50 each
- Televisions \$50
- Computer equipment (CPUs, laptops, monitors, printers) \$50 each

The following items are not allowed and will not be picked up:

- Propane tanks
- Fluorescent light bulbs
- Batteries
- Any mechanical equipment with diesel, gasoline, or oil in it
- Paint cans (not dry)
- Yard waste
- Tires with rim
- Household garbage or recycling
- 'piles' of construction debris

Danville residents may use the Raymond Transfer Station any time of year.
