My name is James Bradbury and I am a retired Massachusetts State Trooper, a retired Danville citizen, and current Chairman of the Town of Danville Building Committee. At present, the Town of Danville does not have a Police Department facility, rather, our police personnel share approximately 700 sq. ft. of hallway and four small rooms in our Fire Department Safety Complex. The committee's only focus is to provide the Town with fiscally sound options encompassing designing, planning, funding, and construction of a building to house the Danville Police Department. I write in support of a request for Community Development Funding.

The committee is comprised of Danville citizen volunteers and is uniformly supported and enhanced with sets of highly specialized skills contributed by the Danville Police, the Board of Selectmen, Planning and Zoning, Conservation, Forestry, and the Danville Fire Department. The Town of Danville is a great community with support from all angles, and it is our intention to maximize that support and make this year the year we finally get this done.

Our current work product consists of a complete design, location, facility, and ancillary expenditures relating to the interior based on the 2020 proposal. We know we must identify what can be adjusted or removed to decrease the overall cost. Items under consideration to lower the price tag are alternate locations, alternate building materials, and possibly alternate designs.
